- 1. Log on to <u>www.schoolinterviews.co.nz</u>
- 2. Click on the 'Make a Booking' box.
- 3. Type the code **nvan2** then select 'Go'.
- 4. Follow the prompts to enter your email address, full name and how many students you are booking for and their name(s). Select '**Go**'
- 5. Choose the teacher(s) you wish to see.
- 6. Select the time(s).

When you have finished, your interview timetable will be emailed to you. You can return to the site and enter the event code **nvan2** again to change or cancel your interviews.
